This is your opportunity to join the Hartlip 100 Club – a great way for you to support the Hartlip Village Hall and the provision of resources for the local community including St Michael & All Angels Church.

Here's how it works:-

- You complete and sign the membership form below and return it with your annual payment of £20 or confirmation of bank transfer. You can have more than one member per house (but members must be over the age of 16).
- Each paid up member receives a membership number which we will allocate. That number enters into the monthly draw (10 per year; no draws in August or December).
- The draw takes place on the last Saturday of each month.
- The prizes will be 45% of the annual income and apportioned over 10 months: 1st prize 50%; 2nd prize 35%; third prize 15%.
- If you win, payment by cheque will be posted to the address on the application form and your name and membership number will be posted on the HVHMC website, "The Forum" and the Hartlip Church notice board.

HARTLIP 100 CLUB RULES

PURPOSE

The purpose of the Hartlip 100 Club is to raise funds. Money received will be paid into the Hartlip Village Hall Management Committee ("HVHMC") bank account and used for the maintenance of the Village Hall and provision of resources for the local community including St. Michael and All Angels Church.

RULES

1. For a cost of £2 per draw, each member will be allocated one number between 1 and 100.
2. There will be a total of 10 draws a year, with no draw taking place in December or August, with 1st, 2nd and 3rd prizes.
3. The prizes will total 45% of the annual income.
4. This will be apportioned over 10 months as: 1st prize of:- 50%; 2nd prize of 35%; 3rd prize of 15%.
5. The 100 Club is a private lottery and is open to residents, Hartlip Village Hall users, those attending Hartlip Church, visitors and friends of Hartlip, provided they are over the age of 16.
6. Payments for the year must be made before the first draw takes place, or if joining part way through the year, the balance for the year is to be paid before entry into the next draw will be permitted.
7. The preferred method of payment is by bank transfer or cheque.
8. One month's notice is required for cancellation of membership.
9. Draws will take place on the last Saturday of each of the 10 months in which a draw is due to take place.
10. Prizes will be paid by cheque within one week of the draw taking place, posted to the address given on the winning member's application form.
11. The names and club numbers of the winners will be posted on the HVHMC website, 'The Forum' and the Hartlip Church notice board.
12. In the event that a prize winner cannot be contacted, the winnings will be retained as HVHMC funds after 6 months to be applied for the purposes outlined above.
13. A member will be deemed to have left the 100 Club if the renewal subscription remains unpaid for a period of 1 calendar month, his membership will cease and his number will be reallocated.
14. The 100 Club is run by HVHMC and in case of dispute, the decision of the Committee is final.
